

Unicomp PC/5250 Keyboard

The Unicomp PC/5250 keyboard has been designed to address the requirements of mid-range customers who need a 122 key model with both Personal Computer and 5250 terminal capabilities. While the PC/5250 has been optimized for IBM Client Access, it should also be compatible with any emulation software package that provides a keyboard-mapping program. The PC/5250 keyboard uses the standard Microsoft 101/102 key driver; no additional programs or unique drivers are required.





FIGURE 1 PC/5250 KEYBOARD LAYOUT - US ENGLISH

The Personal Computer functions, all Function keys and the 5250 keys common to the PC are marked clearly in *black* as shown in Figure 1 below; the 5250 terminal unique functions are printed in blue as illustrated below.




Figure 2 - 19 KEYS THAT OUTPUT MULTI-KEY COMBINATIONS OF STANDARD 101 KEY CODES

To use the PC/5250 keyboard, the user must ensure that the 5250 terminal functions are mapped properly by the emulation software program being used. Most of the key mapping is standard (between emulation packages) and will require no changes to the system's configuration and set-up (See Figure 2). However, some changes will be required to enable specific functions. This mapping is accomplished via the keyboard mapping utility program provided with your emulation software. Experienced users may also choose to directly edit the software's *.KMP file.



Unicomp PC/5250 Keyboard
